Maharaja Ranbir Singh did not establish any school on the western lines during his regime from 1857 to 1885. Maharaja Partap Singh established western type schools in 1886. In 1916, Maharaja Partap Singh invited Sir Henry Sharp, Education Commissioner Govt. of

India, to make suggestions and recommendations to extend educational facilities to the Muslims of the State. His recommendations were :

- (i) A school in every village having 500 or more inhabitants.
- (ii) Liberal grants for Muslim students in schools at all levels.
- (iii) Primary schools for girls.
- (iv) To provide training in Shikasta—a typical form calligraphy and accountancy to village boys.

In 1956 Post-graduate Departments—English at Srinagar and Economics and Geology at Jammu were established. Mr. A.A. Fyzee was its first whole time Vice-Chancellor. The University was shifted to present campus known as Amar Singh Bagh denoted by Dr. Karan Singh

second Vice-Chancellor of the University. In 1965, University was divided in two full-fledged universities having equal status. One for Jammu and other for Kashmir province. At present, there are 12 faculties, 47 academic departments, 21 centres, 36 colleges and 6 other recognised institutes. It is one of the largest universities of the country.
